

MISSIONARY UPDATE: Sam + Jeanette Edelstein

LOCATION: US, Formerly Columbia

Dear friends and family,

This letter is to you who have faithfully, generously and kindly supported us through all these years of ministry in Mexico (when it was just Sam) and us as a family in Colombia these last 15 years. Thank you feels so small...so lacking, so lame somehow. But nevertheless we do thank you... for your belief in us and what God was doing in and through our lives. Thank you for providing, and in doing so, co-laboring with us with many people who have come through our home, our dining room table, and guest room for weeks at a time...so many deep heart conversations, so much laughter, tears and life shared, so much time around God's word, and so so much prayer over and with these strangers that became friends and family. All of this you have been a part of... thank you. As we look back on our lives we are filled with gratitude... and tears. Did we do enough? Did we do it well? Was it all in love? There has been joy and sorrow, so much gained and also lost... only God will know how to fit the pieces together as he works out all things for His good plans and purposes. I asked God recently on a low day, "What if it was all for nothing? What if it didn't matter? None of it..." and I had the thought from Him (I hope), 'but what if -perhaps- I was planting seeds as you scattered them.' Faith.

We have been in Stillwater, Oklahoma, for about 9 months now. It has been an incredibly bumpy landing. We thought we would be having a sabbatical... we planned for a time of rest and reflection we thought we desperately needed after our hectic exit from Colombia, but instead have been barely keeping our heads above water in the logistical nightmare of setting up life. Not really worth getting into all the details. This has been a hard season in our lives, but maybe very normal with such a huge change. We feel we are still very much in the middle of it all... this letter comes at you very raw and live.

We do not, as of yet, know why or for what he has brought us to Stillwater. Our hearts are fully committed to Him and our calling we feel is still for the lost and far from the Lord. We are seeking Him for His guidance, but honestly don't have it yet. Some of you have asked when we will know, what are we doing now, what about their support? We will keep our Navigator account and will continue to only use that gift income for ministry expenses (such as trips back to Colombia and other countries around Latin America to encourage and support). However, we would like to invite each of you to reconsider your financial giving to us. Our hearts are nothing but grateful for the ways you have partnered with us, and we believe God should move His resources as He sees fit. Perhaps there is another ministry or Kingdom venture you would rather support.

It is with so much love for each of you, that we say thank you. Your love, faith and generosity has meant so much to us.
